The Association's general objectives are as follows:

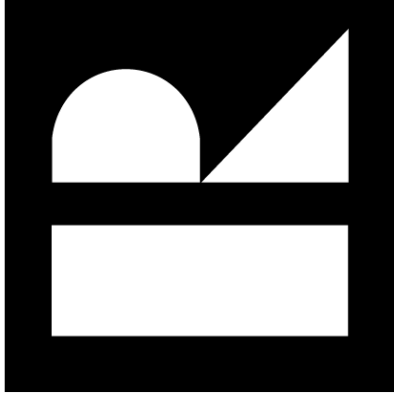
